

Internet Instructions

Complimentary internet access is available in each of the conference rooms and day offices within the suite.

To Connect From a Day Office: The computers in the Vail & Aspen day offices are already connected to the internet, allowing you immediate access to the world wide web. If you have a laptop of your own that you want to connect to the internet, you can disconnect the internet cable from the wall and plug directly into our internet connection. Our routers are set to assign an automatic IP address to your computer.

To Connect From a Conference Room: Wireless routers are located in the Colorado, Denver and Rocky Mountain conference rooms. These can be accessed while using the conference rooms or while in our common areas. To ensure that our bandwidth is not being utilized by other companies within the building, these routers are set-up so that they require a network key to be entered in order to access the internet. The router names and network keys are as follows:

Router Name = Colorado Room	Network Key = 3773575001
Router Name = Denver Room	Network Key = 3773575040
Router Name = Rocky Mtn Room	Network Key = 3773575048

Each router is labeled with its router name and network key for easy reference.

If your computer does not have wireless access or if you simply prefer a cable connection, each of these routers is equipped with four ports into which you can plug in a CAT5 cable. These routers are set to assign an automatic IP address to your computer.
